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Supported by local businesses and organisations, this programme involves a combination of **team building activities, training and work placements** to support adults into professional employment.

This seven-week programme is split into four sections:

Week one

A wide range of induction activities that include working with the Whitehaven Harbour Youth project. During this week you will build on your skills and develop long lasting relationships with fellow cohort members.

Week four

Candidates will have the opportunity to participate in volunteer activities that will also help to increase confidence, gain a sense of fulfilment and further develop skills ahead of work placements.

Week two - three

Candidates have the opportunity to complete workshops and courses to enhance their skills and personal development. Candidates are also given the chance to practice interview skills with a range of employers and complete an occupational studies qualification along with other accredited training.

Week five - seven

Work placements will be available for up to three weeks with local companies. We will conclude with a graduation ceremony for all candidates who have completed the programme, with the chance to speak to prospective employers.

Individuals who take part in the programme will continue to receive universal credit and benefit payments throughout the programme and any travel expenses will be reimbursed.
